

Margaret Gould Z-Club Foundation Scholarship APPLICATION PACKET

Application Guidelines

(Please read carefully as the instructions have been revised.)

Award

The Zonta Club of Hilton Head Island will award college scholarship(s) that may be split among multiple recipients. The scholarship money is sent to the recipient's college or university for the fall semester.

Requirements

Applicants must be:

- An active member of the Z-Club and
- A graduating senior with a minimum GPA of 3.0 and
- Accepted at a college or university by March 31st, of scholarship year.

Instructions

Applicants must complete and submit all enclosed forms <u>electronically</u>, <u>which must be typed</u> (hand written forms will not be accepted). It is the applicants' responsibility to ensure that all forms are received by the Zonta Club of Hilton Head Island via <u>email to:</u> <u>scholarships@zontahhi.org</u> no later than March 31st of the year in which the scholarship will be awarded. Forms may be emailed separately or together.

- Form 1: <u>Application Form</u>. This must be filled out completely and have your name typed in the signature line at the bottom of the form (serving as an electronic signature).
- Form 2: <u>Applicant Statement</u>. This form, along with your applicant statement, must be accompanied with a resume or list of activities and awards. A list of what is to be included in the Applicant Statement is indicated on the form.
- Form 3: <u>Guidance Counselor Form</u>. This form must be completed by your Guidance Counselor and submitted with your school transcript. It may be emailed separately or together along with the rest of the packet to the email address indicated above.
- Form 4: <u>Letters of Reference</u>. Applicants must distribute three (3) Letters of Reference forms which need to be completed and emailed separately or together along with the rest of the packet to the email address indicated above.
 - o One reference from a teacher,
 - o One reference from your Z-Club Advisor,
 - o And, one from a person (employer, community leader, etc.) who knows you well and/or has supervised you in some capacity <u>outside of the school environment</u>.

The selection committee will review the applications and interview a select number of applicants. The scholarship winners will be notified in April and should plan to attend the Zonta Club of Hilton Head Island general membership meeting at 5:00 PM on the first Thursday in May to receive their award. Parents and school officials are also welcome.

- You may include other information you feel is pertinent.
